LANDFILL ITEMS

- ✓ Broken ceramic dishware and glassware
- ✓ Cat litter and animal feces (bagged)
- ✓ Chip bags, condiment packets, or food wrappers that crinkle
- ✓ Composite items made of multiple materials
- ✓ Diapers and feminine products
- ✓ Disposable protective face covering
- ✓ Greasy pizza boxes
- ✓ Foil/plastic-lined juice, soup, or soy milk cartons
- ✓ Plastic items mixed with metal, fabric, rubber or labeled "biodegradable"
- ✓ Plastic bags, film and bubble wrap
- ✓ Rubber or latex gloves
- ✓ Styrofoam, including food trays, packing peanuts and blocks, utensils, and Solo cups

Reduce landfill waste by purchasing items in **compostable or **recyclable** containers.**

PLEASE **DO NOT** PUT THESE MATERIALS IN THE LANDFILL BIN

Put these items in the **Recycling Bin**

- Clean and dry paper products like cardboard and mixed paper
- Glass beverage containers or food jars
- Hard plastics: plastic water bottles, laundry detergent or yogurt containers, and other plastics not labeled "compostable" or "biodegradable".
- Metal: clean aluminum foil, aluminum soda cans or soup cans

Put these items in the **Composting Bin**

- Items clearly labeled compostable: compostable cups, lids, utensils containers and take-out boxes - no wax liner
- Soiled paper products: plates, cups, napkins, paper towels, and tissues
- Food waste or organic matter
- Paper bags

These items go in special designated bins **do not place in recycling or compost bins**

- CDs, printer cartridges, small electronics such as phones, and batteries: place in **Blue Multi-Bins** located all college mailrooms, ARCH laundry rooms, and outside the Camper Park kitchen.
- Batteries: place in **Brown Bins** located in the colleges, administrative and academic buildings.
